2017 Annual General Meeting

The Fund held its AGM at BT Centre in London on 25th July 2017. We were delighted to welcome a number of guests, including representatives from other charities we work with, former Fund Manager Barrie Seaman, and other BT supporters of our work.

Opening the meeting Tom Keeney, Chair of the Trustee Board, said that 2016 had been a demanding but rewarding year and the Fund was in a very stable position. Debbie Terry outlined income and spending during the year, highlighting the fact that grants of almost £732,000 had been made, and that income was over £1million for the third year in a row. The Fund was almost certainly the largest and most active benevolent fund in a UK plc. The meeting approved the 2016 Annual Report & Accounts and Trustee Board elections.

Special mention was made of former trustee and life president Allan Gore, who had died in March at the age of 89. Allan had made an exceptional contribution to the Fund over very many years.



So Far This Year.....

The Fund's made grants ranging from £90 to £4,000 for needs as diverse as new clothes and glasses, disabled adaptations, funeral costs and house repairs, to over 300 individuals and families. At the end of June we were also paying weekly grants to 212 elderly people on very low incomes. We can only do this because of the regular support of our 1,730 employee and 16,090 pensioner members.
